1998 marked the beginning of a new era for Trinity Anglican School with the establishment of the Trinity Anglican School Foundation.

The TAS Foundation was established to raise funds to help build school facilities unequalled in the north. The Trinity Anglican School Foundation relies on the philanthropic support of the School family and the wider Cairns community. Such financial support will secure the future for our school. Some of our projects are highlighted below.

The TAS Aquatic Centre

The White Rock campus swimming pool complex provides a major enhancement of the School's sporting facilities and will allow our sportsmen and sportswomen to achieve their personal goals.

Our heated Olympic Pool allows for the development of a year-round aquatics programme for the School, catering for swimming lessons, competitive swimming carnivals and water polo. It also serves as a recreational facility. The Cairns Trinity Aquatic Swim Club is performing well under the direction of a leading coach.

The eight lane, Olympic Pool (50 metre) features the latest electronic touch timing and computerised time keeping technology. A 25m section is also included. The grandstand seats spectators in comfort, under cover. The complex incorporates full change facilities. An emphasis has been placed on the creation of shade areas around the complex.

The TAS Aquatic Centre hosted the Canadian Olympic and Para-Olympic swimming teams when they trained in Cairns prior to the Sydney 2000 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The Tung Yep Library

The aesthetic appeal of the Marlin Coast Campus is recognised throughout the north. Enrolment growth on our northern beaches means there is a need for further General Purpose Learning Areas and significantly expanded Library facilities to accommodate a growing student population.

The Library can accommodate 100 students simultaneously. As well as a wide variety of reading resources, the Library will also incorporate full electronic learning facilities, linked to banks of CD_Roms and the Internet. The same wing will house new administration facilities to cater fully for our growing enrolment and the resultant expansion in both faculty and course structure. Much needed classroom space, presently employed in administration, will also be released.

What Is the Trinity Anglican School Foundation?

The TAS Foundation is an incorporated body established to secure the School's future through the provision of funds for major facilities development. A Board of Management oversees the Foundation's activities.

Membership of the Foundation is granted to those who make contributions to the Foundation. Contributions to the Foundation are tax deductible. Gifts to the Foundation can be either one-off donations or pledges over a number of years.

There are three categories of Foundation membership - Associates, Fellows and Patrons. Membership of a particular category depends upon the level of gift.

The Trinity Anglican school Foundation is a body constituted to assist the future development of our school. As such, the Foundation will work closely with all sections of the School community, to build a 21st century school, as well as promote the benefits of a TAS Education for young people in Tropical North Queensland and beyond.
